A customized storeroom, Connex, or trailer is stocked with the high volume, consumable materials that you can't do without, but that are a hassle to manage. REMOTE STOREROOM WITH VMI

WESCO's job site solution delivers a customized material strategy which can include tailored shelving, a work area, and electrical and communication hookups. Products are then bin-mapped to the storeroom's storage shelves. Once completed, inventory is checked in to finalize the setup process.

Trailers can be ordered to your specifications with flexible shelving arrangements, heating, air conditioning, power, computer, refrigerator, and more. The most common specs are 24' x 60' Depot, 12' x 60' Depot, 18-wheel trailers; and Connex Boxes from 8' x 20' to 8' x 40' with doors at one or both ends.

THE PROCESS

IMPLEMENTATION

- **MATERIAL SCOPE** – Identify electrical, datacom, and general or industrial MRO materials required for the project.
- **STRATEGY** – Identify "A, B, and C" items that are required on the project and develop a total demand for each identified item.
- **MANUFACTURER LIST** – Develop an approved manufacturer list that aligns with WESCO's standardized stocked materials.

PROJECT PHASE

- **RESTOCKING PROGRAM** – Based on customer requirements and complexity of the project, bin replenishment is used to automatically manage inventory in the storeroom.
- **REPORTING** – Solutions include developing project schedules, open orders and backorder reports, and tracking monthly material use by manufacturer and over the course of the project.

POST-IMPLEMENTATION

- **PROJECT-SPECIFIC CATALOG** – A complete project catalog of items is developed and presented to the project manager at the end of the project.
- **SPEND REVIEW** – Material use is reviewed by project schedule/phase, by product category, or user to drive future process improvement.

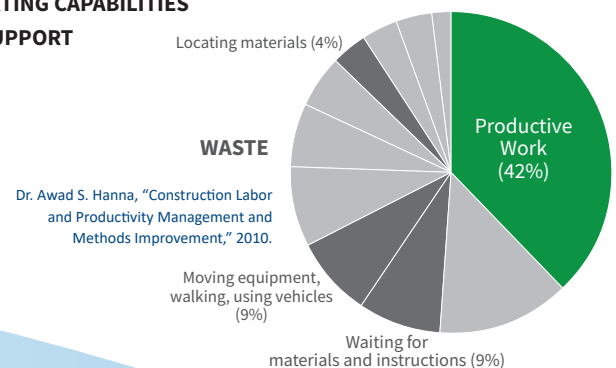

These dispensing systems help supply managers ensure that they have the right quantity of supplies in the right locations, available for storeroom and supply chain managers – every hour of every day.
