  - Electrical power distribution at the 120/240V 1PH usable level

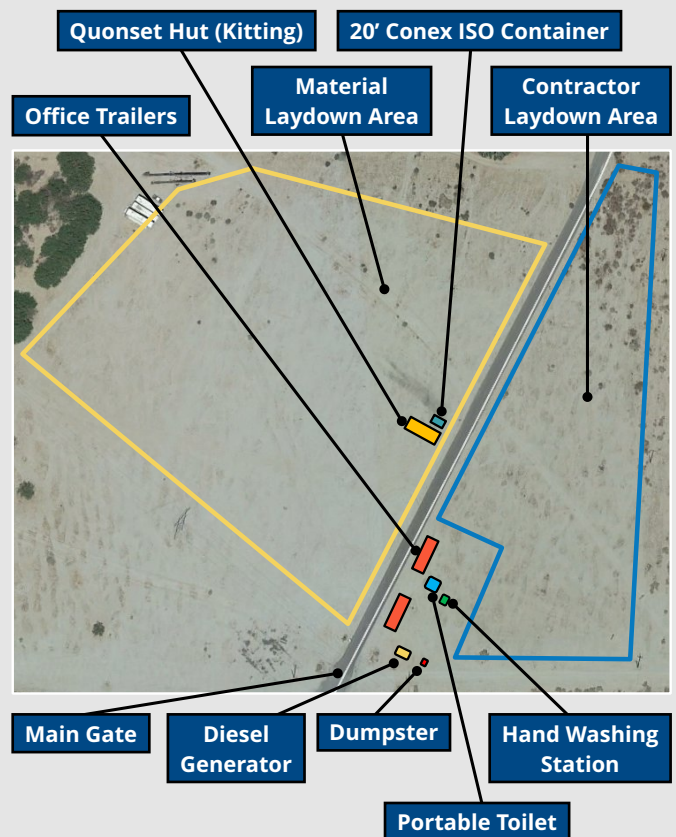
